Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Warm and sunny across England and Wales. Northern Ireland will have variable cloud and sunny spells. Scotland will be cloudier with showery rain in the far northwest, but still see some sunny spells, especially in the east. Mainly dry and chilly overnight, but not quite as cold as previous nights.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A warm, dry day on Friday with plenty of sunshine for most. Cloudier across parts of Scotland with a few showers. Feeling cooler along northeast coasts in the breeze. Rain clearing the north on Saturday, otherwise mainly dry and warm with sunny spells and a risk of isolated thundery showers.
