General Situation

Pressure will remain high across Scotland, bringing settled weather here. However further south a mainly east to northeasterly airflow will bring changeable conditions with showers, thundery and very heavy in places.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northeasterly 4 or 5 for a time in south.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming east or northeast 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or less becoming east or southeast 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast backing east or northeast, 2 to 4, but increasing 5 for a time in Firth of Forth.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering east, 2 to 4.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in north.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 at first in north.

Slight or moderate in the wash, but elsewhere moderate throughout.

Mainly fair until later in north, otherwise showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 5 or 6 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5, then southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in east, decreasing 3 later in west.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 3 to 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth for a time at first in west.

Rain or thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7 veering east 4 to 6, backing northeast 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less, then becoming southwest 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Rain or thundery showers then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 to 7 veering east 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4 becoming southwest 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in north, veering southeasterly 2 or 3 later in south.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast becoming cyclonic, 3 to 5, then becoming west or southwest 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 to 6.
Slight or moderate until later except in Cardigan Bay, otherwise smooth or slight.
Fair then thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, then becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near northern Anglesey.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 to 6, becoming variable 3 at times near cumbria.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near great orme head.
Showers later in south.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in Solway Firth, becoming variable 3 at times elsewhere.
Slight, occasionally smooth except in far north.
Rain or showers in south.
Good, occasionally moderate in south.

Isle of Man

East or northeast 3 to 5.
Slight, occasionally moderate in south.

East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time.

Westerly or northwesterly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first in north

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 to 6, decreasing 3 to 5 by mid-afternoon, becoming variable or cyclonic late evening, then west by dawn tomorrow.

Smooth or slight in the south, moderate in the north, occasionally rather rough mid-channel this morning.

Showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, likely clearing for a time this morning, mist and a risk of fog patches, mainly in the far west.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor or perhaps very poor at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 2 to 4, locally 5 at times, backing southwest overnight.

Slight, locally smooth at times.

Risk of heavy showers in the northwest at first, also mist and a risk of fog patches, clearing northward by midday, then occasional rain or showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate, locally poor or perhaps very poor at times.

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
