Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy and breezy to start across the north with rain across Western Scotland but the wind and rain will ease through the day. Elsewhere, fog patches will quickly clear to leave sunny spells and very warm temperatures. The largely clear conditions continue overnight with isolated fog patches. Breezier across Scotland with patchy rain in the west.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Northern Ireland and Scotland will be largely cloudy on Saturday with patchy rain. Elsewhere, more sunshine will make it even warmer. Central parts will see more cloud on Sunday but it will stay dry. Elsewhere, prolonged sunshine will lead to even higher temperatures.
