

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be mainly dry and bright for most of England and Wales, with perhaps an isolated light shower for Wales and eastern England. Further north it will be colder and windier with showers, occasionally turning wintry. Overnight, strong winds and wintry showers will continue for northern Scotland, but elsewhere it should become clearer, but cold with a widespread frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

It should be settled and dry with sunny periods and light winds for most, however, colder and breezier with some light showers in the far north. Temperatures rather cold in the north, but nearer normal elsewhere with some overnight frost.
