Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain and snow will still affect northern Scotland tomorrow. A few wintry showers are likely elsewhere but mainly fine and bright, though rain will arrive near the south coast later, turning to snow inland. Many places seeing outbreaks of rain, sleet and snow on Thursday too.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It will remain cold and unsettled with a mixture of bright spells and rain, sleet and snow. The snow could be potentially heavy and disruptive in the south of England during Thursday and Friday. Overnight frosts, with a very cold northerly wind setting in from Thursday.
