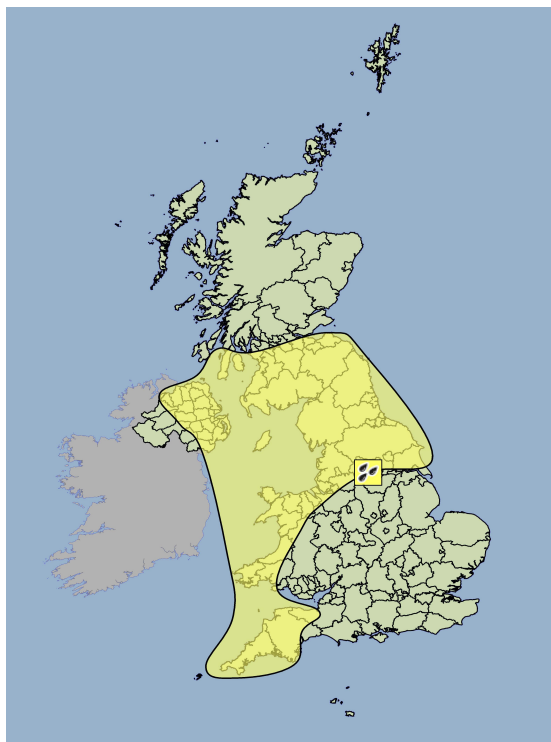




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Slow-moving bands of rain will affect parts of the UK on Saturday. Some locally heavy and persistent rainfall is expected, with the main risk transferring towards Northern Ireland, southwest Scotland and North Wales, whilst the rain should turn more showery across northern England. Elsewhere there will be further heavy showers. 20-40mm is likely to fall, locally in excess of 60mm, leading to some flooding from rivers or surface water. There is still some uncertainty as to where and when the heaviest rainfall and greatest impacts will occur, and this warning may be updated on Saturday.

This is an update to the warning issued on Thursday to include more of southwest Scotland and Northern Ireland, and also to remove parts of England and Wales.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **00:05 on Sat, 07th Sep 2013** until **23:59 on Sat, 07th Sep 2013**

Periods of heavy and persistent rain, as well as some heavy showers, will continue to affect parts of the United Kingdom on Saturday. The public should be aware that there is a risk of localised disruption due to flooding.
