

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Tuesday 05 Oct 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southern and eastern parts of the UK will see outbreaks of rain lasting until late evening. Brighter conditions are expected elsewhere with scattered showers, especially in northern and western parts where they may turn heavy and occasionally thundery, lasting well into the night. Further rain will reach southern England by dawn. It will be very windy in northwestern UK.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain in southeast England will clear to the east during Wednesday afternoon, with bright spells and scattered showers elsewhere, especially towards the west. Thursday should be mainly dry but with strengthening southeasterly winds. Temperatures should remain near or slightly above normal.
