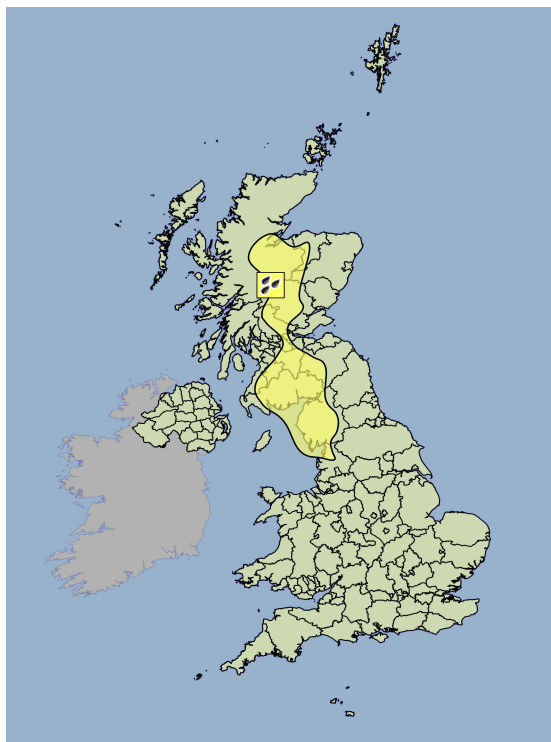




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

A frontal system is expected to run into the UK from the west early on Wednesday, bringing further rainfall and strong winds. This will then sink southeastwards across the UK, clearing through Scotland by around midnight Thursday and clearing northern England early on Thursday.

There remains some uncertainty around the locations to be most affected by this system but further heavy rainfall looks likely across parts of Scotland and northwest England. 20-40 mm of rain is expected widely across high ground and there is a low likelihood of locally seeing 60-80 mm over the highest ground of these areas. Were this to occur renewed flooding is possible given the saturated ground and volume of water running through the river network.

Rainfall totals and further flooding of the level seen over the weekend are not expected.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Rain**

Valid from **06:00 on Wed, 09th Dec 2015** until **03:00 on Thu, 10th Dec 2015**

Further rainfall is expected to arrive across much of Scotland and northern England during the early hours of Wednesday. The rain will become persistent and heavy at times over high ground before clearing to the southeast overnight Wednesday and into early Thursday.

Some very strong winds are also likely in association with this system with gusts of 60 mph possible in places, for which a separate warning has been issued. This could prove a further hazard.

Please be aware of the potential for further disruption from flooding and to transport. This
