Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Eastern districts dry initially, with bright spells. However, cloud and showery rain, already affecting western areas, will move erratically southeast during the day, although parts of southeast England could remain dry. Drier, brighter conditions will follow to northern areas later with scattered showers over western Scotland, locally wintry. Windy generally, with gales or severe gales in northern areas, making it feel chilly.

Rain clearing southern areas during the evening, with many places then dry. However, showers continuing across western Scotland, with rain reaching Northern Ireland later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Mainly dry in the south. Rain in the north. Mild but very windy.
