

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and scattered showers in Northern Ireland and Scotland today. Elsewhere, occasional rain in southern England will spread northwards through the day, turning more persistent and heavy in places and reaching Northern Ireland and northern England by evening. Overnight, the rain will continue northwards to much of Scotland, with England and Wales becoming mostly dry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cool and breezy with rain over much of Scotland, becoming mainly confined to northern parts by Thursday. Otherwise, most places seeing a mixture of sunshine and showers, with many of the showers turning heavy and thundery, but feeling warm in sunny spells.
