Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy with patchy drizzle at first, but some brighter spells developing east of high ground this afternoon, and feeling warmer than yesterday. Heavier rain reaching northwestern areas later and spreading southeast this evening. Drier conditions following across northern Britain for a time before showers and then rain return to northwestern UK. Becoming breezy in southern areas.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

England and Wales wet and very windy on Monday with outbreaks of rain, becoming heavier and more persistent. Elsewhere, rain easing to sunny spells and heavy showers. Sunny spells and showers on Tuesday, some heavy with hail and thunder and wintry over northern hills.
