

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 02 Aug 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, occasionally heavy, in the west continues northwards into Scotland and parts of Northern Ireland. Turning windy, particularly along exposed Irish Sea coasts. Elsewhere, showers, some heavy, and brighter spells. Becoming drier and less breezy from the south later. Overnight, rain continuing in the northwest, but otherwise mainly dry with clear spells, easing winds and isolated showers.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain in Northern Ireland and Scotland gradually clearing Sunday with winds steadily easing. Drier in the south, with warm sunny intervals and isolated showers. Sunshine and showers on Monday, showers most likely in the west and southwest. Temperatures near normal, warm in southeast.
