Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Many places starting dry with local frost and patchy mist/fog, very slow to clear in Scotland and northern England. Rain in southwest spreading across Wales, much of England and Northern Ireland, followed by sunny intervals and scattered heavy showers in the southwest. Far north of England and much of Scotland brighter, a few showers, mainly in the east. Quite windy in south, making it feel cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Friday unsettled, prolonged rain in northern England spreading to Wales. Heavy showers, sunny intervals rest of England. Scotland and Northern Ireland rather cloudy, showers in north. Saturday mostly dry as rain clears eastwards.
