Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
It will be a chilly start in places, but with plenty of sunshine.  
However, patchy cloud will develop and bring a scattering of showers,  
and some of these will become rather sharp for a time, especially in  
the west, before turning lighter towards evening. It should feel  
pleasant in any sunshine and just gentle breezes.

Tonight, Showers will die out away from the northwest, but increasing  
cloud and wind will bring rain into many western areas later. It will  
again be a chilly night in the east.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will become cloudy and wet after a chilly but sunny start in  
the east. Rain will clear Thursday night to leave Friday a very  
blustery day with sunny intervals and squally showers.
