Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud and rain, sleet or snow into the southwest spreading northeast across Wales, the Midlands and the rest of Southern England with snow mainly becoming confined to hills in North Wales and Northern England overnight. Eastern and southern Scotland remaining showery with further snow accumulations in places.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

During Saturday rain across most parts of England and Wales clearing to occasional showers, with snow across the higher ground of Wales and Northern England. Scotland mostly cloudy, with rain, sleet or snow across southern and central parts. Sunday remains unsettled with further bands of rain and showers spreading across most parts.
