Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be cloudy with rain at times over Northern Ireland and Scotland,
persistent across northeastern Scotland, with snow on higher ground. Elsewhere,
there will be plenty of sunny spells and some scattered showers, these locally
heavy. It will be rather cold with light winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain and showers in the west will spread east during Thursday, the showers
becoming locally heavy and perhaps thundery, before mostly clearing in the
evening and becoming confined to the far west. Light winds will freshen in the
west. Further showers and sunny spells are expected on Friday, the showers again
locally heavy.
