

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Occasional wintry showers across northern and eastern areas with perhaps a further covering of snow across some northern hills. Isolated showers also clipping the west coast of Wales and Southwest England. Elsewhere, becoming largely sunny once any early showers clear. Feeling very cold in brisk northerly winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A few wintry showers continuing towards eastern coasts, but many areas dry and bright on Thursday. Cloud thickening in western areas later perhaps bringing some rain, sleet or snow later. Overnight rain, sleet and some snow petering out during Friday, with most places becoming dry. Staying cold with overnight frosts and winds easing.
