Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mostly dry with some sunny spells for many, after a locally chilly and foggy start in places. Some showers affecting the far southeast. Meanwhile, it will be turning windier across northwest Scotland with some rain arriving later, which will spread southeastwards overnight, weakening as it does so.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Mainly dry with sunny spells for many after a chilly start in the southeast. Rain will be arriving into the far northwest, with freshening winds. Wet and windy on Wednesday, becoming mostly dry for Thursday and Friday. Windy at first, with gales in the north. Temperatures returning to normal, with milder nights.
