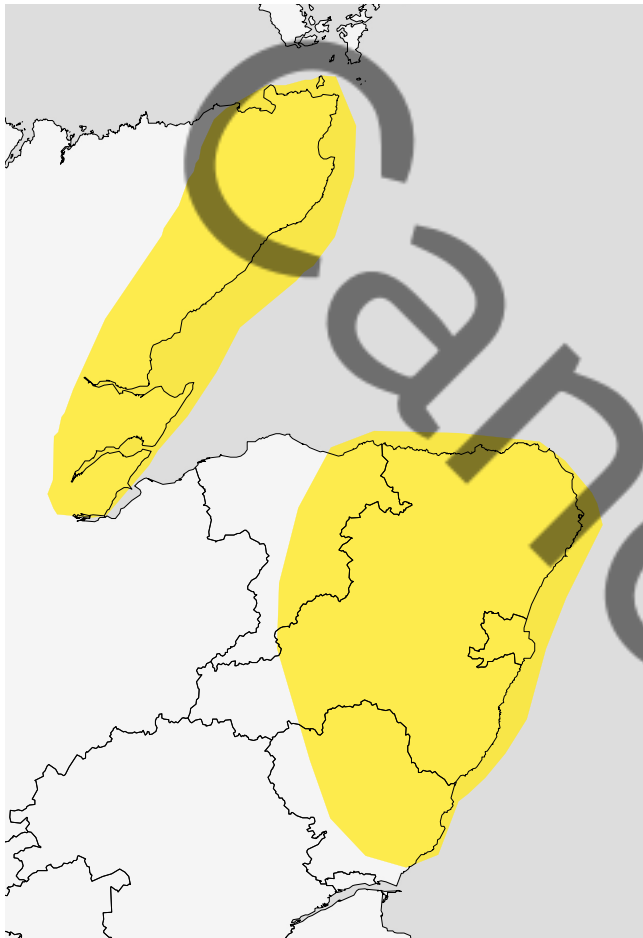


**Yellow warning

**Persistent and heavy rain on Saturday likely to bring some disruption from flooding.****What to expect**

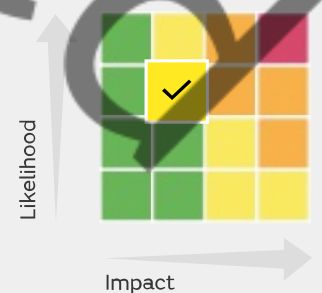
- Flooding of a few homes and businesses is likely
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer

**Further details**

Persistent and occasionally heavy rain is expected to develop across northeastern Scotland on Saturday. Rainfall accumulations of 25 to 40 mm are likely through Aberdeenshire, eastern Moray and northern Angus and as much as 60-80 mm across Easter Ross and Caithness, perhaps a little more over high ground. Rain will lose intensity through Sunday.

**Reason for cancellation**

Heavy rain has now cleared the warning area.
