Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, heavy at times will spread across most parts today though the far north of Scotland will escape the worst. Brighter, more showery weather will spread into western areas this afternoon but the rain will linger in the east. Rain will eventually clear here overnight. Elsewhere it'll be dry but mist and fog will develop over Scotland and N.Ireland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
Mist and fog over Scotland and N.Ireland will lift to leave a dry but cloudy day on Wednesday. Elsewhere some brighter spells are likely to develop. On Thursday most places will be cloudy but largely dry. Brightest in the east. Warm.
