Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Wednesday will be much cloudier and cooler than Tuesday. Any fog patches should lift as sporadic outbreaks of rain spread erratically north, mainly affecting western areas with places further east remaining mostly dry. The best of the brightness will probably be in west and northwest Scotland and southeast England.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Occasional drier and brighter interludes, especially in the south on Thursday, but most places will be cloudy with outbreaks of rain and drizzle. It will be windy, especially in the north, and it will feel quite chilly. It will also be misty and murky over the hills, particularly in the east.
