

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Saturday 02 Feb 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold, dry and mostly sunny day today, with a scattering of wintry showers affecting eastern coasts and during this morning western Wales and southwestern England. Staying dry initially overnight with an early frost developing but rain and hill snow will gradually spread in from the northwest reaching all but the southeast by dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Overnight rain clearing the southeast during the morning, leaving a cloudier day with some outbreaks of rain in the north and west. Feeling milder than Saturday, after a cold start in the east. Turning colder, clearer but showery Monday, with severe gales developing across the northwest.
