Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Showery outbreaks of rain or sleet, falling as snow on hills, spreading across much of Scotland, though southeast should remain mainly dry. Northern Scotland becoming brighter with showers. Sleet or snow showers across Northern Ireland and North Wales, spreading inland in northwest England, dying out overnight. Elsewhere, plenty of sunshine. rather more cloudy later. Winds decreasing, but still feeling cold.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain, heavy at times, spreading northeast on Friday to nearly all parts, becoming misty in south as temperatures rise. Further rain all parts, clearing England and Wales on Saturday, followed by blustery showers with gales. Cold far north Scotland.
