Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
A fine start for most with some sunshine, especially across southeastern parts. However, rain will soon reach Northern Ireland this morning, spreading to western parts of Scotland, Wales and England during the afternoon. Ahead of this rain some isolated thunderstorms are possible, especially in northern areas, but most eastern areas should remain dry and fine. Temperatures near normal in the wetter northwest, but hot again towards the southeast.

Outbreaks of thundery rain will continue to cross the country, lying across northeastern parts by dawn. Becoming mainly dry behind with patchy fog.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Mainly dry with sunny spells. Very warm in places.
