

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry and often sunny for most of Britain. Cloudier in western and northern parts, with Scotland, Northern Ireland and later Cumbria seeing rain from the northwest. Wintry showers following into northwestern Scotland before dusk. Overnight, becoming breezy countrywide, with rain continuing southeastwards across the UK. The north then seeing further rain, strong westerly winds and snow; mainly over Scottish hills.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Windy and rather cold towards the northwest, with longer spells of rain separated by brighter intervals, wintry showers and some snowfall. The snow settling and perhaps drifting in parts, mainly over Scottish mountains. Drier and brighter towards the southeast throughout.
