Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Scotland, Northern Ireland, showers and sunny spells, best sunshine  
in the east. Frequent, occasionally heavy, wintry showers in north,  
becoming more widespread further south. Elsewhere starting fine, then  
showers developing inland. More prolonged rain and freshening winds  
reaching southern and western districts later. Feeling quite chilly,  
particularly in north.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday, rain clearing southern England and East Anglia, then sunny  
spells and showers over England and Wales. Wintry showers and strong  
northerly winds over Scotland and Northern Ireland. Sunday, strong  
winds over the northeast easing. Wintry showers in the north,  
decreasing in northwest. Sunny spells and scattered showers in south.  
Cold.
