Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will be slow to clear southeastern parts of England, probably not clearing the far southeast until after dark. Elsewhere bright and breezy but with blustery showers, the showers heaviest and most frequent across northern and western areas. Feeling cooler than recent days. Showers will persist overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Further blustery showers on Monday, and perhaps some more persistent rain across the far southeast, which could be heavy at times. The best of the drier, brighter weather for central areas. Bright spells and showers again on Tuesday, showers wintry over hills in the north.
