Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A rather cloudy day for most parts of the United Kingdom with some drizzle at times, mainly in the east and perhaps turning to light sleet or snow over high ground. Bright or sunny spells are likely in sheltered western parts of England and Wales, and also in Western Scotland. Feeling rather cold generally.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Remaining rather cloudy on Monday with some rain, sleet or snow showers in the east, but generally brighter and drier in the west. Some bright or sunny spells in the west on Tuesday, with further sleet or snow showers, mainly in the east. Becoming colder.
