

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Wednesday 03 Feb 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

Rain is expected to spread from the west during the morning, with strengthening southeasterly winds. Rain should continue northeastwards during the day with some heavy downpours in places, possibly turning to snow over higher ground in northern England. Scotland should stay dry and cloudy for much of the day, but rain and hill snow should spread here in the evening.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain should slowly clear eastwards during the day on Friday, leaving drier and brighter conditions for all but Scotland during the afternoon. Mostly dry and cloudy on Saturday with brighter intervals at times and a few outbreaks of light rain.
