Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
For England, Wales and Northern Ireland, a mainly dry and rather cloudy day but with a few bright or sunny intervals in places. Although southern Scotland will start dry and cold with some sunshine, rain spreading to the north this morning will extend to southern areas this afternoon. Temperatures near or a little below normal.

Tonight, rain in the north will spread south across England and Wales but with some places staying dry.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain in south clearing otherwise mostly dry Thursday with a few sunny intervals. Rain will spread southwards on Friday followed by colder northerly winds and wintry showers.
