

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 05 Dec 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain across the north will gradually ease and become patchy, while sometimes heavy showers affect western and southern coasts. Further cloud and rain, locally heavy, will spread northeastwards this afternoon across southwest England, then Wales and Northern Ireland, then reaching remaining areas this evening. Clearer conditions will follow to western areas, along with scattered sometimes heavy showers. Temperatures near average.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Sunday rain, often heavy, will clear from across eastern England and the Northern Isles by midday. Sunny spells and showers will follow, the showers mainly along western coasts. Monday eastern areas will remain dry, while rain arrives in the west.
