Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cloudy for many with perhaps some fog lingering in western parts at first.
Outbreaks of drizzle are likely at times, especially in the east where a little
sleet is possible. Bright or sunny spells are possible in far western parts.
Staying cloudy overnight, with light rain, sleet or snow continuing in the east.
Cold, and locally frosty.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Outbreaks of rain, sleet or snow for northern and southeastern parts on Monday.
Drier and brighter across Wales and central and southwest England. Drier and
brighter in the west with scattered snow showers in the east on Tuesday. Chilly,
with fresh northeasterly winds.
