Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a frosty start in the northwest and a few early showers, the UK will be dry with light winds. There will be plenty of sunny spells in northern and western parts, and a few in the south and the east. Cloud, rain and stronger winds will reach western parts overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
Rain, strong winds and milder air will move eastwards across the country on Saturday accompanied by gales in the north. As rain clears, sunny spells and blustery showers will develop in the northwest. Sunday will be mild and windy with bright spells, but rain in the north and west.
