

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 08 Mar 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Isolated light showers initially across southern England and northern Scotland,
otherwise dry with patchy fog clearing, and bright or sunny spells. Rain will
spread southeast across Scotland and Northern Ireland this afternoon, then
remaining areas of the UK this evening and overnight, clearing from most places
by late night. Overnight showers will follow the rain across Northern Ireland
and Scotland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday early rain across southeast England soon clearing. Then sunshine and
showers, the showers often heavy and wintry, most frequent across northern
areas. Saturday rain across Northern Ireland and Scotland, later northwest
England and Wales, elsewhere mainly dry and bright.
