

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A frosty, perhaps icy start is expected across northwestern Britain, with wintry showers through the day. Elsewhere, wet and windy weather will continue eastwards, with sleet and snow expected, especially from the Pennines northwards. Colder, clearer conditions following, with blustery, sometimes wintry showers. Rain, sleet, snow and strong winds will become confined to eastern and southeastern England overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Wet and windy, initially wintry weather will continue across southeastern England during Monday. Elsewhere, it will be mostly dry and bright with some showers, wintry on northern hills. Tuesday will be largely fine and chilly but turn unsettled from the northwest later.
