

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 07 Mar 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Heavy rain continuing in the northwest producing large upland rainfall accumulations. Elsewhere, dry, cloudy in the west with the best of the sunshine across south-eastern parts and to east of hills; where very mild. Windy, especially in the north. Rain edges south-eastwards overnight with cooler, clearer, showery conditions following. Cloud increasing in the southeast, but dry.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Rain moves southeast and weakens Sunday, clearing all but the far south later. Clearer, cooler conditions following with wintry showers over Scotland, locally heavy. Windy in north with gales, easing elsewhere. A chilly start Monday, then turning wet and windy, particularly in the northwest.
