

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 21 Jan 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northern Scotland mainly dry with bright or sunny spells. Cloudy elsewhere, with rain, heaviest across Northern Ireland, northern England and the high ground of Wales. Snow on northern hills and locally to lower levels. Tonight, becoming dry with winds falling light and skies clearing, widespread frost developing with ice on untreated surfaces. Cloud and rain spreading to the west later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cold and dry over central and eastern parts at first Tuesday but with rain already in the west spreading east across all parts. Heaviest rain over western hills. Mild and breezy on Wednesday, most of the rain in the north.
