General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here. Elsewhere various lows and troughs will bring rain showers, some thundery in south. An Atlantic low will then move over Ireland later on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast, backing east or northeast later, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later near Cape Wrath.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight later, occasionally moderate near Cape Wrath.

Showers.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

East or northeast 3 or 4, backing north or northeast later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight.

Northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less, then southeast 3 or 4 later.

Slight, but moderate at first in north.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Cyclonic 2 to 4, increasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in Thames estuary.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Cyclonic 3 to 5 becoming westerly or northwesterly 2 to 4, then variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in northeast.

Rain or showers.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

Southwesterly 4 to 6, decreasing 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in east, becoming smooth or slight.

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southwest for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or showers, thundery at first.

Variable 4 or less, becoming south or southwest 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in west.

Showers, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Northeast 3 to 5 becoming variable 4 or less.
Smooth or slight.
Rain or showers, thundery at first.
Good, occasionally poor.

Variable 4 or less, becoming south or southeast 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later
near st david's head.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in southwest.
Showers, rain later.

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northeast 2 to 4 later

Slight, but smooth in lee shelter just east of Shetland

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to southwest 2 to 4, increasing 5 at times, backing south to southeast later.

Slight, locally smooth.

Isolated showers in the evening, mainly in the southeast of the area, locally heavy and thundery occasional rain by midday tomorrow, mainly in the southwest of the area, with occasional drizzle and fog patches later.

Good, occasionally moderate, perhaps locally poor at first, becoming moderate to very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 2 to 4, becoming cyclonic and increasing 5 at times overnight, becoming west to northwest 3 to 5 by mid morning, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth to slight, with a low swell developing.

Rain at times fog patches and occasional drizzle clearing by mid morning on Tuesday.

Moderate to very poor, becoming good, occasionally moderate.
