Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Many places will start grey and misty with patchy thick fog in places, especially in the south, along with a little drizzle. However, this should gradually lift and break, then most places will have a dry day with some bright or sunny intervals. It will however, turn cloudier in the west later, perhaps with a little rain in the far west by evening. It will feel warmer than of late in any sunshine, but it will become rather breezy in the north and west.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Rain in the north and west for a time, otherwise mostly dry and warm with some sunshine.
