

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 03 Jul 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Becoming very wet across Northern Ireland later this morning, with some  
torrential downpours this afternoon. Elsewhere across Britain, the day will be  
partly sunny with a scattering of heavy showers. Northern Ireland's heavy rain  
will only slowly move away to the north through tonight, while across Britain  
showers largely die away to leave a mainly dry night.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Largely fine on Friday, with only a sparse scattering of light showers. Some  
heavier showers for western Scotland though, and turning wet and windy in the  
southwest later on Friday. Spells of wet weather for most places on Saturday,  
bar the far north.
