Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Wet and windy for the Northern Isles today, otherwise, largely dry and fine with some sunny spells. A scattering of showers are likely in the west, but generally fairly light. Cloud and rain will spread from the southwest this evening, becoming increasingly persistent overnight with some heavy bursts at times.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Wet and windy for many on Sunday. Rain will move northwards, with heavy bursts likely. Becoming very windy across southern then eastern parts, with gales in places, possibly severe. Bright and very breezy on Monday, with sunny spells and scattered showers. The showers will be heavy at times. Feeling cool.
