

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 10 Feb 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Icy start in places. Rain across some southern and southeastern areas slow to clear southeast England and East Anglia. Otherwise, dry and bright for many, but bands of showery rain will move eastwards across the UK at times. Becoming largely dry this evening, but rain will spread from the west through the early hours, heavy at times, with hill snow.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain and hill snow clearing eastwards on Tuesday, not clearing East Anglia and the far southeast until mid afternoon. Sunshine and showers then follow, heavy at times and wintry on hills. Turning wet and windy from the south later Wednesday.
