

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 30 Nov 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain will spread eastwards across Britain today, heaviest across west Wales.  
Hill snow will affect Northern Ireland, southern Scotland and northern England  
but elsewhere staying mild, but windy. Overnight, the north will have clear  
periods, wintry showers and a frost. Further south it will be much milder with  
some rain, which will extend northwards later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Tuesday will be wet and windy in the north with some temporary snow, perhaps  
heavy, before it turns milder. Further south there will be patchy rain and mild  
southwesterly winds. Wednesday will be another wet and windy day as rain spreads  
southeast across the UK.
