

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 26 Nov 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Any early morning frost and fog patches will gradually clear, leaving a mostly dry day with variable cloud and some sunny spells. However outbreaks of rain, strengthening winds, but also milder temperatures will spread across Scotland during the day. These conditions then edge southwards overnight, although clearer spells in far south will lead to the risk of fog and frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

A rather murky but milder mid-week with cloud and hill fog becoming persistent in places with outbreaks of drizzle, and the risk of fog to lower levels as well. The best of any brighter spells will be in the northeast.
