

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Sunday 09 May 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scotland generally cloudy with outbreaks of light rain or sleet. A few moderate bursts expected on windward slopes, giving a light covering of snow on the highest ground. The rest of the UK staying mostly dry but a scattered light or moderate showers will develop, most frequently in Wales and northern England. Fresh northerly winds over Scotland, moderate northeasterlies elsewhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Both days start mostly clear, with light frost in many northern and eastern places. Most of the UK will stay dry and sunny, feeling milder due to lighter winds, but a decaying rain band will creep southeastwards over northern UK.
