Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It should be a dry day for much of the UK with plenty of warm sunny spells.
These are likely to become quite prolonged across Wales and southwest England in the afternoon. However, rain is expected to reach Northern Ireland and northwest Scotland later in the evening. Winds will be light and quite variable.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain will continue to spread southeastwards on Monday, becoming intermittent but affecting many parts of the UK. Further rain will affect southern England on Tuesday with scattered showers elsewhere, especially across Scotland. Winds should remain light and southwesterly, with temperatures staying around normal.
