



## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Cold air coming off the continent will be met by a band of frontal rain over Northern England, which will turn to a mix of rain and sleet, with snow on high ground. Over eastern, and especially northeastern Scotland, a feed of showery rain from the North Sea in cold air will give a similar wintry mix. The front will clear south overnight into Monday, whilst the showery airstream will be more persistent over Scotland.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Snow**

Valid from **06:00 on Sun, 10th Feb 2013** until **10:00 on Mon, 11th Feb 2013**

A band of rain pushing into Northern England, and a stream of showers running into eastern Scotland, will both turn to snow on Sunday, mainly above 200 m. Accumulations of 3-6 cm are expected in places, with 5-10 cm above 300 m and, over Aberdeenshire, Angus and Perth & Kinross, more than 15 cm by Monday morning at these higher levels.

Rain, sleet and snow will die away from Northern England and parts of Scotland on Sunday night, leaving a legacy of icy stretches on paved surfaces for Monday morning. Over eastern Scotland snow is expected to continue on high ground, with ice on roads and pavements at lower levels. The public are advised to be aware of these wintry hazards.

This is an update to the warning issued on Saturday to extend the area further west across southwest Scotland into Dumfries and Galloway, and also Ayrshire.
