Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Storm Caroline will bring storm force winds across Scotland, combined with frequent snow showers. It will be mild, wet and windy across England and Wales at first, turning brighter and colder later with snow showers, mainly in western and central areas but occasionally more widespread at times.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday blustery snow showers will continue across northern and western areas, and occasionally more widespread with some significant accumulations for some. Outside of the showers it will be dry and sunny, but cold everywhere. Showers will ease through Saturday, remaining very cold with hard overnight frosts.
