

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Mostly cloudy across the UK with outbreaks of drizzle in western parts, but mainly dry further east. Persistent rain and freshening winds in Northern Ireland will spread eastwards during the afternoon into western Britain. This rain continues eastwards overnight, turning heavy for a time across Scotland with brisk winds, but remaining mostly dry until dawn in southeast England. Feeling muggy.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain slow to clear eastern and southeastern England on Saturday, but then becoming drier during the afternoon. Elsewhere, often cloudy with some brighter spells and a few showers. Sunday, much drier and brighter, but a few showers in the northwest.
