Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Rain over much of Scotland and Central England gradually petering out today. Further patchy rain over Eastern England and the far northwest. Elsewhere, rather cloudy, but dry. Mild.  
Patchy rain will continue across southeast England and northwest Scotland tonight. Dry with some clear spells elsewhere. Ground frost is likely under clear spells across southern Scotland and northeast England.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Rain will slowly spreading from northwest Scotland down to north Wales and northwest England during Wednesday. Patchy, light rain over northwest Scotland will become more persistent later on Thursday. Otherwise dry with occasional sunshine. Mild on Wednesday, temperatures around normal on Thursday.
